Isaiah 55:8 For My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are My ways your ways,' declares the Lord.

-Our thought...it's an interruption.

-His thought...it's a divine intervention.

-The interrupted life is a privileged life.

Jonah 1:1 The Word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai saying...

-The interrupted life is a significant life.

2 Kings 14:25 In the fifteenth year of Amaziah son of Joash king of Judah, Jeroboam son of Jehoash king of Israel became king in Samaria, and he reigned forty-one years. He did evil in the eyes of the Lord and did not turn away from any of the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, which he had caused Israel to commit. He was the one who restored the boundaries of Israel from Lebo Hamath to the Dead Sea, in accordance with the word of the Lord, the God of Israel, spoken through his servant Jonah son of Amittai, the prophet from Gath Hopher.
