Jonah 1:1-3 Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the second time, saying, **2** “Arise, go to Nineveh the **great city** and proclaim to it the proclamation which I am going to tell you.” **3** So Jonah arose and went to Nineveh according to the word of the Lord. Now Nineveh was an **exceedingly great city**, a three days’ walk.

-God’s grace in our mess becomes our **greatest** testimony.

-God’s call sends us to an ‘exceedingly **great** city’.

Definition of **great**: very much above the normal size, quality or volume

-God has given us a **great** commission.

Matt 28:18-20 Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **19** Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”
