Our next study will be Wednesday, April 20. We will be studying Colossians 3.

**Jonah 4:5-11** Jonah had gone out and sat down at a place east of the city. There he made himself a shelter, sat in its shade and waited to see what would happen to the city. **6** Then the Lord God provided a leafy plant and made it grow up over Jonah to give shade for his head to ease his discomfort, and Jonah was very happy about the plant. **7** But at dawn the next day God provided a worm, which chewed the plant so that it withered. **8** When the sun rose, God provided a scorching east wind, and the sun blazed on Jonah's head so that he grew faint. He wanted to die, and said, "It would be better for me to die than to live."  
**9** But God said to Jonah, "Is it right for you to be angry about the plant?" "It is," he said. "And I'm so angry I wish I were dead."  
**10** But the Lord said, "You have been concerned about this plant, though you did not tend it or make it grow. It sprang up overnight and died overnight. **11** And should I not have concern for the great city of Nineveh, in which there are more than a hundred and twenty thousand people who cannot tell their right hand from their left—and also many animals?"

Daniel 3:25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.

Luke 24:36 While they were telling these things, He Himself stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be to you."

John 19:18 ...they crucified him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.

Revelation 7:17 For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."

Matthew 18:22 Where two or three are gathered in my name, there I am in the MIDST of them. He is positioned in our midst bc He is our priority.

Psalms 22 My God, my God, why have You forsaken me? Why are You so far from my deliverance and from my words of groaning? **2** My God, I cry by day, but You do not answer, by night, yet I have no rest. **3** But You are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel. **4** Our fathers trusted in You; they trusted, and You rescued them. **5** They cried to You and were set free; they trusted in You and were not disgraced. **6** But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by men and despised by people.

Exodus 26: **31** "You are to make a veil of blue, purple, and scarlet yarn, and finely spun linen with a design of cherubim worked into it. **32** Hang it on four gold-plated posts of acacia wood that have gold hooks and that stand on four silver bases. **33** Hang the veil under the clasps and bring the ark of the testimony there behind the veil, so the veil will make a separation for you between the holy place and the most holy place. **34** Put the mercy seat on the ark of the testimony in the most holy place.
